
After turn on the main switch on control panel, turn on this switch then machine will work.

1. turn off switch on handle.




2. turn off main switch on main body.

Reading guide

The following symbols and terms are used throughout this manual to alert the reader to safety issues and important information:

<u>^</u>	WARNING	Indicates a hazardous situation which, if the safety instructions are not followed, can lead to injuries of the operator orbystanders, light and/or moderate damage to the product or the environment.
	STRONG MAGNET	Indicates the machine contains strong magnets. These can cause pacemakers to stop or cause electronic data to be damaged, for instance on information stored on access passes.
(EX)	PACEMAKER	Indicates operators and maintenance crew wearing pacemakers should keep a minimal distance of 6 inch/15 cm. In this specific case operators may not use the machine as a backpack.
	BATTERIES	Indicates a battery operated machine, batteries must be charged according to the instructions in the separate Class I Battery Charger user manual. Batteries must be disposed of according to your local laws and regulations
	PROTECTIVE EYEWEARE	Indicates protective eyewear isadvised, for instance when filling the machine with cleaning solution
	WASH HANDS	Indicates the operator is advised to wash their hands, for instance after filling and/or draining the cleaning solution.
	HOT SURFACE	Indicates hot surfaces of parts ofthe machine. Hot surfaces can cause burns in contact with skin over longer time.
	SLIPPERY SURFACE	Indicates the machine can cause floors to become slippery. Marking the workplace with slippery surface signs is advised.




1. fill tank with solution and assemble it on main body.






2. assemble nozzle on handle, choose spray nozzle according to your requirement, install it on nozzle head. You can also use the extend tube to increase your spray range.
